<b>Trial Name:</b> Australasian Leukaemia and Lymphoma Group National Blood Cancer Registry	
<b>Lay Summary:</b> <p>Cancer registration schemes are important for research into the type and cause of cancer. They are part of today's modern health information system.</p> <p>The linking of biological samples with baseline and outcome data collected together in real-time allows us to trace the patient journey through data collection and to also capture the biological events through specifically timed sample collections.</p> <p>The NBCR began in 2012 as an Acute Myeloid Leukaemia (AML) registry. It has since grown to encompass additional types of blood cancers and has been renamed the National Blood Cancer Registry (NBCR). The NBCR now collects data and matched samples for the following types of patients:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Acute Myeloid Leukaemia (AML)</li> <li>• Acute Lymphoblastic Leukaemia (ALL)</li> <li>• Uncommon Lymphomas <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Extranodal marginal zone B-cell lymphoma of mucosa-associated lymphoid tissue (MALT lymphoma)</li> <li>○ Splenic marginal zone lymphoma</li> <li>○ Nodal marginal zone B-cell lymphoma</li> <li>○ Lymphoplasmacytic lymphoma / Waldenström macroglobulinemia</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p>The intention is to gradually build capacity of the registry activities to encompass all blood cancers over the course of the next 5–7 years with a target of activating 80% of ALLG sites including the addition of all New Zealand member sites that wish to participate.</p>
